DCT LOCATION

Students will study in a purpose-built college facility at Dubai's Department of Economy and Tourism headquarters. This unique location will provide students with proximity to the industry and a vibrant working environment that will inspire and educate students while introducing them to the everyday practices of their chosen career.

The campus is located at One Central on Sheikh Zayed Road between the Dubai International Convention and Exhibition Centre and Emirates Towers, and is just a ten minute walk from the Dubai World Trade Centre metro station. This vibrant location at the epicenter of Dubai's events, business and hospitality industries provides an unrivalled environment for students to be based.

The DCT Kitchen for the culinary arts students is a professional teaching facility located at Meydan Grandstand, consisting of 3 hot kitchens and a pastry kitchen.

TOURISM

Tourism is a collection of activities, services and industries that delivers a travel experience, including transportation, accommodation, food and beverage establishments, entertainment businesses and other hospitality services for people travelling away from home.

Studying Tourism at DCT exposes students to a range of tourism services and skills providing a sound knowledge of both office and field-based industry functions and the confidence to apply them in the real world.

Dubai is one of the leading tourism and hospitality destinations in the world, and currently ranks 1st regionally and 2nd globally, in the Top 100 City Destinations Index 2022 @Euromonitor International. In 2023, Dubai was crowned the No.1 global destination in the Tripadvisor Travelers' Choice Awards for a second successive year, consolidating its position as the world's favorite tourist destination. The recognition supports the goal of the Dubai Economic Agenda D33 to consolidate Dubai's status as one of the world's top three destinations for tourism and business.

The rapid growth of Dubai's tourism industry means that there are more employment opportunities in this sector, and the practical focus of this course will open doors to the industry's top employers. DCT graduates will be ready to take on roles with inbound and outbound tour operators, tourism boards and information centres, destination management companies and more.

PROGRESSION

All programmes at Dubai College of Tourism have been designed to help students excel in their chosen speciality and to prepare them to directly enter the workforce. Previous graduates have secured positions with companies such as Emirates Airlines, Jumeirah and Hilton.

Students who wish to pursue with their education at DCT, can continue to the second year of our programme, which focuses on teaching students more supervisory, teamwork and leadership skills while also studying elective specialist subjects and completing a longer mandatory internship placement of 4 months.

STUDENT WELL BEING

INTERNSHIPS

DCT partners with some of the leading names in the industry to provide our students with the best internship opportunities and guarantees a 6-week industry internship to all eligible first year students and a 4-month internship to all eligible second year students. They are mandatory for all students because they put into practice the skills and ideas learnt in class. They are also credit bearing, and therefore essential in order to graduate.

NETWORKING

Activities like site visits, meeting industry speakers and internships provide our students with the opportunity to establish important contacts and broaden their network of references for their job search.

CV WRITING

Students go through a rigorous process of designing their CV and learning to write their cover letters which is adapted to each programme and tailored to the industry needs.

MOCK INTERVIEWS

Practical skills also include mock interviews where students are offered a chance to practice interviewing for potential job roles while learning how they can ace interviews with confidence.

E-PORTFOLIOS

Along with their LinkedIn profile, students are taught to create an e-portfolio to showcase their skills for future employers.





INDUSTRY EXPOSURE

SITE VISITS: Students enjoy observing how their learning is practiced in the professional environment through visits to some of Dubai's most prestigious hotels, event venues and tourism attractions. Culinary students visit a multitude of professional kitchens, markets and farms.

INDUSTRY SPEAKERS: A range of guest speakers from the industry typically visit the college for guest lectures and enlighten the students with their knowledge and experience. This provides students with great insights as well as excellent networking opportunities.

VOLUNTEERING: All students will be able to participate in a series of volunteering opportunities at some of the most prestigious events in Dubai and the UAE. Previous opportunities have included: Dubai Fashion Week, Formula One, Arabian Travel Market, Dubai Fitness Challenge, Dubai Food Festival and Dubai World Cup.

INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

DCT encourages applications from international students from around the world. The student body typically consists of more than 25 nationalities which helps to create its unique diverse and dynamic learning environment reflective of the industry sectors taught.

Students benefit from living in the heart of a world-leading tourism destination, which is also one of the world's safest cities. Recent legislative changes offer extended study and post-graduation visas in addition to the regular one-year renewable student visa.

Students can also work part-time. Gain invaluable real-life experience with part-time jobs in the fashion industry, working at a major exhibition, or as a meet and greeter at a theme park.

All students enrolled at DCT complete internships (unpaid) that are a mandatory part of the programme secured by the college. Students also have the opportunity to seek internships (paid or unpaid) during holiday periods.

STUDENT VISAS AND INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

It is a requirement to have a valid visa allowing you to study and live in the UAE as an international student. DCT's admissions team will assist all international students with the visa process to obtain a student visa.

Once offered a place on a course, students have 30 days to accept their place and secure it by paying the non-refundable deposit of AED 1,000. This amount is later deducted from the total programme fee.

Emirati and UAE residents will be able to pay the fees in termly instalments spread across the academic year (September to July).
